

## **BigFix Enterprise Suite Console Operator Course Syllabus**

Duration: Approximately One Half Day (4 Hours)

This course is designed to train BigFix Enterprise Suite Console Operators, who are responsible for the administration of BigFix Enterprise Server on a defined subset of computers (servers, desktops, laptops) within the enterprise.

This is a hands-on course, conducted in a laboratory setting. At the end of this course, attendees will have the skills to do the following:

- Understand the basic architecture, network topology, and relay structure used in the enterprise deployment of BigFix Enterprise Suite within their enterprise
- Identify each of the computers that have been assigned to them
- Identify specific fixlets that are relevant to each of the computers.
- Deploy actions to single computers or to groups of computers
- Monitor actions that have been deployed
- Create analyses that are used to track characteristics of computers
